FALCON GAMES 2012 RULES OF THE GAMES

- 1. Trinidad and Tobago Athletes registered with the NAAA and athletes registered with their respective Federations for 2012 will be allowed to participate in the Games.
- 2. All Athletes must have their REGISTRATION NUMBER securely attached to their back and front of their tops.
- 3. All registration forms must be filled in properly, and <u>ALL FEES</u> due and payable <u>MUST</u> accompany the Registration Forms when submitted.
- 4. The meeting will run under the rules of the Organizing Committee and Competition Rules 2011/2012 of the International Association of Athletics Federation (IAAF).
- 5. The Organizing Committee of the Games reserves the right to refuse entry, cancel an event or frame a new event should it become necessary to do so.
- 6. Athletes must compete in their age groups unless permission is granted by the Organizing Committee.
- 7. Athletes who are entered in the Multi Events cannot be entered in the individual events.
- 8. Juvenile and Junior athletes must submit a copy of their Birth Certificate, as proof of date of birth, if so required by the Organizing Committee.
- 9. Athletes in the Juvenile and Junior Categories must not attain the ages of 9, 11,13,15,17 and 20 respectively during 2012.
- 10. No National Uniforms (of any country) are to be worn by participants except where National teams are competing.
- 11. The committee will not be liable for any injuries suffered by any participant or damage to any participant's equipment as a result of traveling to and from, participating in, or presence at the games.
- 12. Competitors MUST report to the Call Room in accordance with the Call Schedule. Failure to do so may result in the Competitor's disqualification.
- 13. Competitors will only be allowed on the track and centre field only when participating in an event. Officials reserve the right to disqualify any competitor for the infringement of this rule. Competitors may be disqualified from the meet for misconduct.
- 14. Betting is strictly prohibited amongst athletes.
- 15. Events with **three (3) or less competitors** or **clubs** may be scratched or considered an excebition event. Semi-finals or Timed Final will be held where there are more participants than that particular event can accommodate.
- 16. If there are more than eight (8) teams registered for a RELAY event, the Organizing committee reserves the right to withdraw a team where more than one team is registered from the same club
- 17. As soon as events are declared OFFICIALLY, prizes will be distributed, and athletes or their representative must present themselves at the prize enclosure when called.
