## **Rules of the Competition**

- 1. The meet shall be called Quantum Invitational Track & Field Classic.
- 2. The control of the meet shall be vested in the Organizing Committee.
- 3. International athletes will be provided with numbers and armbands for participation.
- 4. All local athletes must wear their 2012 NAAA registration numbers.
- 5. Participants in the meet are by invitation only.
- 6. Competitors must be properly attired in accordance with internationally accepted standards.
- 7. Each relay team must wear the same color uniform.
- 8. Teams and participants' arrival will be accommodated from 2: pm.
- 9. The Call Room and warm up track is situated at the north of the main stadium behind the stadium scoreboard.
- 10. Competitors are responsible for reporting to the Call Room on time.
- 11. Competitors must report 30 minutes before the start of their track events and one hour before for the start of their field events. Failure to report on time will result in the competitor missing their event.
- 12. Athletes are not allowed on the track or centre field except when required to participate in an event.
- 13. All electronic devices are prohibited in the Call Room and Competition Area. The Meet Organizers will not be held responsible for the loss or damage of any such items.
- 14. Competitors will be escorted from the Call Room prior to the start of their event.
- 15. All races are final. Where there is more than one section, then the combined result will determine the awardees.
- 16. Athletes must make themselves available for award presentation immediately after their events. In event that they are unable to do so as a result of medical condition or for preparation for another event, a suitable replacement must be sent for awards. Awardees shall assemble in the VIP area and will be escorted to the prize rostrum on the main field.
- 17. 1st, 2nd, & 3rd in each event will be awarded.
- 18. Any protest of results must be made in accordance with the IAAF rules and procedures.
